Furniture etiquette

Pet accessories

Comfortable, well-rested pups are happy pups! We have provided a medium size padded dog bed for your pup to curl up on and snooze during the night. We ask that your furry friend does not sleep on the couch or on beds please. We have provided a food and water bowl, we ask that you do not use the property crockery as bowls please.

Responsible pet supervision

Our retreat is blissfully surrounded by the Arakwal National Park. The park plays host to many protected species and small colonies of endangered birds. It is important to keep your pet inside the retreat's fully fenced yard unless it is leashed and supervised.

Vocal pups

In consideration of our neighbours and other holiday makers, excessive barking is not considered acceptable behavior.

Pooch poops

The retreats lush tropical gardens are the perfect environment for your furry friend to play and relax. It is the pet owner's responsibility to collect and remove all pet waste from the property prior to checking out. An additional cleaning fee will be deducted from the security if pet waste is not removed.

Byron Bay is a pretty pet-friendly neighbourhood, with several dog beaches and exercise areas... Pups on leads are widely accepted around town.

Dog friendly beaches

The dog friendly zone starts at a point adjacent to Jarman Street Suffolk Park and extends north to the boundary of Arakwal National Park.
